ORGANIZATION INFORMATION

The Dream Big Project (DBP) is a 501(c)3 Non-Profit Organization that is operated by a community of individuals who are passionate about educating, inspiring, and providing for underserved youth. The Dream Big Project scholarship is designed to financially assist graduating high school seniors as they begin their journey in higher education. We believe in a world in which youth of all backgrounds, ethnicities, and abilities have an equal chance to make their dreams come true through higher education.

OUR STORY

Dream Big Project was founded by Miguel Wong-Rivera in December of 2014 in the city of Norwalk. The inspiration behind DBP is rooted from Miguel's personal testimony. A few nights before Miguel's first day of college, and a little over two months after graduating from Norwalk High, a night of drinking and having fun with his friends led him to make an unconscious decision. Miguel attempted to drive himself home, but before he could reach his destination, he was in a car accident that left him with the inability to walk. He was only 18 years old.

OUR MISSION AND VISION

The mission of Dream Big Project is to provide underserved youth with academic support, financial assistance, and leadership training. Embracing the power of community and compassion, Dream Big Project leverages community partnerships to administer programs that serve youth in Norwalk and surrounding communities. Ultimately, Dream Big Project envisions a day where a Dream Big Project Wellness Center exists to serve people of all ages and stages of life, with emphasis in education, youth development, and wellness.

APPLICATION PROCESS

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

The following is required for consideration of the 2022 Dream Big Project Scholarship:

- Must have community service experience.
 - Must graduate with a minimum of a 2.0 G.P.A.
 - Must be a part of high school graduating Class of 2022
 - Open to Class of 2022 graduates in Norwalk - La Mirada and surrounding communities
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APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Scholarship applicants must apply by the deadline, May 27, 2022.

Scholarship decisions are made by the scholarship committee of Dream Big Project.

The scholarship application can be found on pages 5-6. It is essential to include all materials listed on the scholarship application when application is submitted.

Failure to do so, and to do so in a timely manner, may result in not being considered for the Dream Big Project Scholarship.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- **One letter of recommendation** from an individual who is familiar with your academic work and community involvement , i.e., teachers, counselors, administrative staff, supervisors, or mentors with sufficient experience to offer an informed and compelling statement of your skills, qualifications, and passion for education and community service (recommendation form on page 8-9).
- **Personal statement** must reflect your community service and outreach experiences in your community, and how said experiences have played a role in the development of your professional and personal growth. (guidelines on page 7).
- **Official transcripts** from all high schools attended. If you attended the same high school for grades 9-12, then you will only need to submit a transcript from the one high school. If you attended more than one high school, then you must submit transcripts from each.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Applicants will be asked to provide additional items:

- Proof of Volunteer Service Hours
- Proof of Enrollment to Accredited College or University for Fall 2022 semester/quarter

SELECTION PROCESS

Phase 1: APPLICATION PAPER REVIEW

You must submit all of the items listed on the program application. The scholarship committee will review the program application materials approximately 1 week after the deadline. You will be notified by email regarding the status of your application. All applicants will be contacted once the review process is completed by June 10, 2022.

Phase 2: ORIENTATION

Applicants who are selected for the scholarship will be invited for a mandatory meet and greet with the scholarship committee. This will be scheduled as a meet over Zoom. This serves as an opportunity for both scholarship recipients and representatives of the committee to get to know one another and to talk more about upcoming event and scholarship award distribution.

Note: Students who are granted the scholarship must be present at our Annual Scholarship Awards Ceremony in the city of Norwalk. Accommodations and changes can be made due to COVID-19. Scholarship award will not be disbursed until proof of enrollment is presented to the committee, even if this moves forward of awards ceremony.
